Dear Centennial High School Parents/Guardians of Returning and New Students:

Enclosed you will find a packet of forms for you to enroll (or re-enroll) your student in the Health and Wellness Center at Centennial High School. Students at Centennial have onsite access to receive medical and/or mental health services right in the school. This is the only school based health center in the school district and our goal is to ***Create Healthy Learners Better Prepared for Academic and Life Success!***

We are unable to see or treat students without a completed enrollment packet that is updated each school year. **Please complete the packet if you think your student may want or need to use any of the services, at any time, this year.** **We never turn any student away for inability to pay or for not having insurance!** **All students who enroll in the Center may use the medical and mental health services, but we have to have the signed enrollment and consent materials.**

Like other medical or mental health providers, the Health and Wellness Center can and does bill most insurance, (including Medicaid and CHP+). If you have health insurance:

- No copay is collected for services, due to a special accommodation allowed by the state of Colorado only for School Based Health Centers.
- Please be sure to provide your insurance information or complete the “income attestation for sliding scale services” so that you do not receive a bill for the full amount.
- When you receive billing statements they will be from Rocky Mountain Youth Clinics in Thornton, CO.

Sliding Fee Scale, Medicaid/CHP+ Enrollment Assistance, Inability to Pay:

If you are NOT currently insured:

- The Center offers a sliding fee scale. Please complete the section entitled “income attestation for sliding scale services” on the back of the Registration Form. We will contact you regarding the scale.
- We are also a certified Medicaid enrollment assistance site and can discuss eligibility for this program with students/families that do not have health insurance.

CHECKLIST:

- A parent or guardian must sign all of the forms if the student is under 18 years of age; students 18 and older sign their own forms.
- If you have insurance (including Medicaid/CHP+), please copy the front and back of your card and return the copies with the packet.
- Have your student bring the forms back to Centennial and drop them off in the Health Center’s main office, room 205 or you can email them to hwchs@rmyclinics.org or mail to: The Health and Wellness Center at Centennial, 330 E. Laurel Street, Fort Collins, CO 80524.
